PROOF OF FINANCIAL SUPPORT

A recent bank statement(s) in the name of the sponsor, listed above, must also be provided with this form. The following conditions must be met:

- 1 The name on the bank statement must match the name (exactly) of the sponsor stated above.
- 2 The information on the bank statement must be dated within 3 months of the submission date.
- 3. Proof of property ownership and proof of employment are NOT sufficient evidence of fund availability.

Please note: The bank statement will need to show at least the minimum amount required for the program, as shown on Page 2.

If an applicant has more than one sponsor, a bank statement and a Statement of Financial Support Form must be submitted for EACH sponsor.

Application Cancellation Refund Policy:

If the embassy in your home country has declined your visa application for any reason, any money you have deposited with us will be refunded, **excluding** the application and postage fees. Any and all fees and charges incurred will be paid by the student.

^{*}There are two mandatory semesters in one academic year – Fall and Spring. These costs are based on a student enrolled in full-time classes for two semesters. If the student is bringing dependents, additional cost \$4,000 for the **first** dependent and \$2,000 for **each additional** dependent.

Living Expenses: Each student may choose living accommodations or other expenses, which would cost more than the amounts listed above. This is an estimate of minimal expenses only. It is advised that each student should arrive in the U.S. with at least \$2,500 in cash to cover "settling-in" expenses.

Fees:

Student Service Fee \$75 Academic Spring and Fall semester

(paid with tuition, upon enrollment in Courses) \$50 Academic Summer I and Summer semester

Tuition and Fees:

- Subject to change without prior notice. Money for personal expenses (books, supplies, etc.) is **not** included in tuition
- ESL semester tuition is based on 20 hours per week instruction. Full-time ESL students are required to attend 20 hours of classes per week.

Housing:

- The university does not provide housing or dormitories. Students are responsible for their own living accommodations.

- The average annual living expense (housing and food) in the Washington, DC area is \$12,550 per student. These estimated expenses are for a single student, with no dependents (spouse or children).
