Book with an editor

Editor last name, editor's initials (Ed.). (date). Title of work. Location: Publisher.

Example: Shotton, M.A. (Ed.). (1989). *Computer addiction? A study of computer dependency*. London, England: Taylor & Francis.

Periodicals

Author's last name, Author's initials. (year). Title of article. *Title of Periodical*, xx, pp-pp. doi: xx.xxxxxxx

Example: Herbst-Damm, K.L. (2005). Volunteer support, marital status, and the survival times of terminally ill patients. Health psychology, 24, 225-229. Doi:10.1037/0278-6133.24.2.225

Newspaper Article (Online)

Author's last name, Author's initials. (Date of article publication). Article title. *Newspaper Title*, pp. A1, A4.

Example: Brody, J.E. (2007, December 11). Mental reserves keep brain agile. *The New York Times*. Retrieved from http://www.nytimes.com

Website with an author

Author's last name, Author's initials. (Date of article publication). Article title. Retrieved on Month, Day, Year, from web address.

Example: Martin, K.J. (2014). Brainstorming. Retrieved on May, 14, 2014 from http://viu.edu/wrmc/writing-lab/tips-and-strategies/brainstorming.html.

Website without an author

Title of article/page (date of publication). Retrieved on Month, Day, Year, from web address.

Example: Brainstorming (2014). Retrieved on May, 14, 2014 from http://viu.edu/wrmc/writing-lab/tips-and-strategies/brainstorming.html.

Unpublished (SELF) Citation

Author's last name, Author's initials. (Date of article publication). *Manuscript title*. Unpublished manuscript, Location where submitted.
